

CLASSICAL PERFORMANCE (BRASS, PERCUSSION, AND WINDS), MM

The CCPA Master of Music performance program prepares students for careers as solo, chamber music, and large ensemble performers, while instilling habits consistent with success in the professional environment. The program's objectives are to:

- Refine technical and musical skills with study and performance of challenging and advanced repertory;
- Provide ongoing ensemble performing experiences, with higher expectations for leadership in collaborative musical situations;
- Prepare students for the rigorous demands of the music profession by teaching the discipline and self-motivation necessary to achieve excellence;
- Introduce students to the traditions, operations, practices, and opportunities of the professional symphony orchestra;
- Provide opportunities to investigate topics and repertoires in advanced coursework.

RECITAL REPERTOIRE

PERF 428 GRADUATE RECITAL

Brass: 60 minutes of music is required. Chamber music may be included with the permission of the applied teacher. The recital will be graded by the applied instructor and at least one other faculty member.

JURY REPERTOIRE

Brass: Ten minutes of music. The repertoire should consist of a major work for the instrument, or an alternate piece presented with the permission of the applied professor. No repetition of repertoire from previous juries is allowed. Individual faculty members are encouraged to implement additional requirements for students in their studios, to which their students are bound.

Grade Requirements

- **Applied Lessons:** B- is the minimum passing grade for PER 411 PERCUSSION (MAJOR).
- **Recitals:** B- is the minimum passing grade for PERF 428 GRADUATE RECITAL

RECITAL REPERTOIRE

PERF 428 GRADUATE RECITAL

Percussion: 60 minutes of music, to be divided among marimba/vibraphone/xylophone, timpani and multi percussion/advanced snare drum solo suite. All recital repertory requirements are at the discretion of the applied instructor. Recitals are graded by the Program Director and one other faculty member.

JURY REPERTOIRE

Percussion: All jury requirements are at the discretion of the applied professor.

Grade Requirements

PERF 428 GRADUATE RECITAL

Woodwinds: 60 minutes of music is required. Chamber music may be included with the permission of the applied teacher. The recital will be graded by the applied instructor and at least one other faculty member.

JURY REPERTOIRE

Woodwinds: Fifteen minutes of music. Students are strongly encouraged (and some may be required by their applied professors) to perform solo literature from memory. All repertoire must be approved by the applied professor. No repetition of repertoire from previous juries is allowed. Individual faculty members are encouraged to implement additional requirements for students in their studios, to which their students are bound.
