

FINANCE, MINOR (FOR NON-BUSINESS MAJORS)

The Finance minor for non-business majors provides students with basic coursework in Finance. Courses include; Money & Banking: Principles of Finance; Corporate Finance or Investments, one 300-level elective course in Finance and basic Business courses including Principles of Accounting I and Principles of Economics I & II.

Requirements

A non-Business student who wishes to take a Finance minor must take seven classes total. At least four of the courses must be taken at Roosevelt University, and all courses must be passed with grades of C- or higher with an average of at least 2.0. Students must complete all prerequisites for courses in their chosen minor area.

The Finance minor is highly compatible with the following majors: All majors within the Heller College of Business, Actuarial Science, Data Analytics, Economics, Mathematics, Real Estate.
