

GRAPHIC DESIGN, MINOR

The Graphic Design minor prepares students with manual and computer skills to create and manipulate graphics, style text, and arrange visual elements for publishing, design and advertising studios and business organizations. Students will utilize industry-standard software. Completion of this minor is intended to supplement students' chosen field of study by providing them with additional skills in visual communication, creative thinking and design, as well as technical acumen and proficiency in professional design software.

Prerequisites

COMM 110 COMMUNICATION IN THE INFO AGE is the prerequisite course for this minor (grade C or better).

Requirements

Six courses (18 credit hours) are required for the minor in Graphic Design.

- Transfer students must complete at least three DES courses (9 credit hours) at Roosevelt.
- No pass/fail grades are accepted for this minor.
- All courses for the minor must be completed with a minimum grade of C (not C-) or better. The overall grade point average required in minor courses is 2.0.
