

# POLITICAL SCIENCE, MINOR

A minor in Political Science (<https://www.roosevelt.edu/academics/programs/bachelors-in-political-science-ba/>) pairs well with almost any major or program of study at Roosevelt University. Whether you plan to pursue a career in journalism, medicine, physics, or mathematics, an understanding of the political realm will help you navigate the policy environment in your field of choice. The minor offers in-depth knowledge of local, national, and international political processes. Political Science faculty at Roosevelt University emphasize issues of social justice across the course offerings, allowing majors in any discipline to graduate as socially conscious citizens capable of sustained engagement with public affairs.

## Requirements

- The Political Science minor consists of 18 credit hours.
- At least 9 credit hours must be a combination of 100-level and/or 200-level courses.
- At least 6 credit hours must be at the 300 level.
- All courses in the minor must be completed with a grade of C or higher and a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- At least 9 credit hours of Political Science coursework must be completed at Roosevelt University.
