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# INTERDISCIPLINARY THEATRE STUDIES, BA

The Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Theatre Studies is a liberal arts degree with significant curricular flexibility. It is designed for students who desire a foundational training in acting and performance, yet also wish to expand their studies into other aspects of theatre-making (stage management, design, dramaturgy, playwriting, etc.) or combine their theatre studies with other disciplines. The degree map is designed to provide the student with an opportunity to build an individualized program, geared towards developing as a multi-hyphenate artist.

Auditions for theatre productions and select applied coursework conform to the requirements and processes of the Conservatory, and occur after the student has matriculated and at a point appropriate in degree progress, in consultation with the student's advisor.

At least 12 credits must be at the 300-level. No more than 12 credit hours at the 100-level may be counted toward the major.

#### **Grade Requirements:**

Grades of C- or higher are required in all theatre (THAR) courses at the 200- and 300-levels.

#### **GPA Requirements:**

Students must maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher in the major.

### **Residency Requirements:**

The final 30 credit hours toward a student's degree must be completed at Roosevelt University, or a minimum of 60 hours must be taken in residence at Roosevelt University.

At least 15 credit hours in the major must be taken at Roosevelt University.
