PERFORMING ARTS, MINOR

The Performing Arts Minor is open to undergraduate students in any undergraduate degree outside of CCPA. It is ideal for those students who wish to pursue performing arts studies to complement or enhance their major area or build on their previous musical or theatrical activity. The study of the performing arts develops the capacity to identify, integrate and apply materials, choices, and techniques to form new ideas and create new and unique work. Thus, it combines well with any humanistic field as well as technical or scientific disciplines.

Five courses (15 credits) are required for the performing arts minor. At least two of the courses must be taken at Roosevelt University. Minimum grades of C- are required to fulfill minor requirements.
